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### 1. Where is the announcement posted?

**2. The last sentence states "Submit your SF330, no more than 15 pages to describe equipment, and no more than 3 additional pages to..." Is the USGS asking that our entire submittal be no more than 18 pages (Part I and Part II (complete SF 330))? Or is the 15-page restriction only for Part I, Section H, Specialized Experience and Technological Competence, (2) Photogrammetric Equipment? Also, for the "no more than 3 additional pages" statement, is this to answer the remaining selection criteria? Please clarify what the USGS is asking in relation to this sentence.**

The last sentence "Submit your SF330, no more than 15 pages to describe equipment, and no more than 3 additional pages to the contract address above and to ATTN: Randa Usel, Contracting Officer, (303) 236-9318." **will be replaced with** "Submit your SF330 to the contract address above and to Attn: Randa Usel, Contracting Officer, (303) 236-9318. Please respond directly to the selection criteria above using Section H. Additional Information. Section H is limited to 75 pages."

**3. The solicitation does not indicate the service area for the proposed IDIQ contract. Can you identify the area(s) where potential projects would be performed?**
